Founded in 1988, The International Geothermal Association (IGA) is a scientific, educational and cultural, non-profit, non-political and non-governmental organization. IGA operates worldwide with a membership of > 5000 from greater than 65 countries. IGA headquarters is located in Bochum, Germany.

IGA encourages and coordinates research and educational activities world over related geothermal resources. It promotes scientific and technical activities through publications amongst geothermal scientists, business organizations, governments, UN organisations.

IGA is governed by a Chairperson, Vice-chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer and 30 Board of Directors. The Board of Directors are elected by vote by all the members

IGA is a founding partner of REN Alliance (International Renewable Energy Alliance) that has links with renewable energy associations operating across the world. REN Alliance partners are IHA (International Hydropower association), ISES (International Solar Energy Society), WBA (World Bioenergy Association) and WWEA (World Wind Energy Association).
